

WHAT IS EXTENDED CARE?

(available for children enrolled in our 3 and 4 year old classes)

Read on to learn about our popular extended care program!

When is the program available?

This program is made available any or all weekday afternoons based on demand.

When can my child participate?

You may sign your child up as a “**regular**” or a “**drop-in**”.

As a “**regular**”, you indicate which day or days your child will stay at extended care.

As a “**drop-in**”, you can check with the office if there is availability on the day(s) you would like your child to stay. This can be as late as right before extended care begins. We have a calendar in the office for you to sign your child up or you may call the office.

Your child may attend any afternoon even if it is not a day your child attends school.

What are the hours?

Extended Care starts immediately after Lunch Bunch and ends at 3:00 pm.
(Lunch Bunch ends at 12:00 pm for all morning classes.)

Can my child stay for a shorter time?

Yes, you can pick up your child prior to 3:00 pm, however, you will **not** receive a rate deduction.

What is the teacher/child ratio?

Up to 7:1

Where is the Extended Care program and what do the children do at Extended Care?

This class is held in the nursery school area of the church building. The children will have the opportunity to partake in circle times, quiet time (naps if the child chooses), craft activities, outside playground time, music and free choice time in the environment under the supervision of fully qualified staff persons.

What is the cost?

A “**regular**” rate is **\$25** per day or **\$100** per month for each day per week your child participates. Regular Extended Care is billed in advance on your monthly statement. Regulars have the benefit of the “regular” rate even when dropping in on another day. A “**drop-in**” rate is **\$30** per day. Drop-In Extended Care will be billed to you on the next monthly statement.

As a regular, can I trade the regular day I am enrolled for another day?

Yes, you can do this if there is availability. Check with Jeannine in the office.

What about holidays that fall on my regular extended care day?

You can trade for another available day. It is your responsibility to keep track of how many “trades” you have.
